Use this registration form to pay for all homecoming and reunion events, including '72 apparel which you were asked to pre-order starting in June. Remember to pay for football game tics as well.

Reminder: There is one exception to this; Class golf tourney entry fee is being handled separately, as signed on golfers have been advised via email with payment instructions.

As announced in June, 50th Reunion Class Clothing items must be pre-ordered not later than July 20th, then paid for using the Alumni Association registration form above. Why the need to pre-order? The apparel order to the manufacturer has to be submitted before the Alumni Association order form will probably be available. So pre-order (binding agreement) your gear not later than July 20th, then only order and pay for items you pre-ordered, using the Alumni Association Homecoming Registration Form.

Medallion Ceremony Protocol

Our Class is the guest of CGA and the Alumni Association who sponsors the event each year for the 50th Class, and Greg is spending considerable time coordinating with the Alumni Association to make this event special. Dress Code

Medallion Ceremony: Navy Blue Blazer, light blue or white shirt, tie (Class tie or Mate's choice of tie), dark gray or charcoal dress slacks (no khaki please, I repeat, no khakis).

Uniform for March-On: Blue Blazer plus Class Shirt (shirt optional) – Black long sleeve mock turtle neck shirt with multi-color rendition of the Class ring crest on the front. Casual trousers, including dress jeans (no holes).

Dress Code for other Class Specific Events: Casual (coat and tie optional). Since the Class Dinner on Friday follows the Medallion Ceremony, Mates may elect to “dress down” and remove coat and tie if they so wish.
